NARRATIVE

On 8/14/17 at 11:41pm, Deputy Ariel and I were dispatched to a domestic disturbance at [REDACTED] Milwaukie. It was reported a male and female were having a verbal and physical fight. With yelling and thuds coming from the apartment. On the way to the call we were also informed there was a PC statement records for the male in that apartment for a domestic disturbance earlier in the week. The male and female were identified as Timothy Jarvis and Dianna Bennett from the previous calls at the location.

Deputy Ariel and I arrived at the apartment complex. Deputy Ariel went to the back of the building to watch the window into the apartment. I entered the building to go to the front door of the apartment. I heard Deputy Ariel say over the radio, Bennett had removed the screen from the back window and was screaming for help. I arrived at the front door and could hear movement inside the apartment. Based on the circumstances I believed the Bennett was actively being assaulted or in danger.

Deputy Ariel met me at the front door of the apartment. I removed my gun from the holster and had it in a low ready position. Deputy Ariel and removed his taser and had it ready. He knocked and announced Sheriff's Office. I heard a female voice respond, "Fuck you, you aren't coming in here". Deputy Ariel stated she needed to open the door and or we would kick it in. Bennett opened the door wearing only a t-shirt which was inside out and backwards. Deputy Ariel asked her where Jarvis was and she responded by saying, "Fuck you". Deputy Ariel pulled her from the doorway to give us access to the apartment.

When Deputy Ariel pulled Bennett from the doorway she was in between the two of us. She immediately spun around and punched Deputy Ariel from behind in the right side of his head near his ear. She punched him with a right closed fist. I holstered my gun. I was concerned if I did not take immediate action she would continue to assault Deputy Ariel. I grabbed her left arm with my left hand and the side of her head with my right hand. I pulled her to the ground onto her stomach. I placed my knee on her back to control her movement and detained her in handcuffs. I checked the cuffs for tightness and double locked them.

Deputy Ariel and Deputy Brown cleared the apartment and Jarvis was not in the apartment. At midnight I informed Bennett of her Constitutional Rights as Per Miranda. I asked her if she understood her rights and she said, "You killed my sister, I know". She continued to scream in an irrational manner and make nonsensical statements. Based on my training and experience she appeared to be under the influence of methamphetamine. We found shorts for her in the apartment and put them on her. I placed her in the back of my patrol vehicle and advised her she was being audio and video recorded.

I transported Bennett to the Clackamas County Jail. On the way to the jail she told me she had used meth the night before. Video of the transport was uploaded to the Arbitrator server. At the jail she was uncooperative with the jail staff. She was placed in a solitary cell and immediately stripped

off her clothes and started screaming. I left her in the care and custody of the jail staff.

| <p>On 8/14/17 at approximately 2342 hours, I was dispatched with Deputy Alexander to a domestic disturbance at [REDACTED] in Milwaukie. A caller reported hearing what sounded like a physical disturbance inside the residence, with thuds against the wall.</p> <p>I arrived several minutes later with Deputies Alexander and M. Brown and approached the building from the back side. As I was walking past the back of the apartment, which was on the second story of the building, a female pushed a screen out of the window. The screen fell down to the grass below, and the woman yelled, "Help me! Call my sister!"</p> <p>I radioed to Deputies Alexander and Brown what I was seeing, and ran to Deputy Alexander, who was at the front door of the residence. We knocked on the door and I announced, "Sheriff's Office" several times. A female voice yelled back that she would not open the door for us, but after we advised her that we would kick the door in if she did not, she opened the door.</p> <p>I saw a female standing in a t-shirt, naked from the waist-down, standing in the doorway. I could see several pieces of overturned furniture behind her, and feared there was a second person hiding inside the studio apartment out of view. I asked the female where the male was, and she proceeded to swear at me. Unable to see much past her and wanting to bring her to safety to separate her from her alleged attacker, I grabbed her by the arm and pulled her out of the doorway and into the hall, passing her off to Deputy Alexander who was behind me.</p> <p>I was still standing in the threshold of the door. The female yelled more explicatives which caused me to momentarily shift my attention from the apartment to her. As I turned my head, I saw a closed fist coming toward me out of the corner of my eye, and felt it forcefully impact the right side of my head. Surprised, I turned around and saw Deputy Alexander grabbing onto the female with both of his hands and forcefully pulling her to the ground. We detained the female without further incident while she protested loudly. She continued her profanity-laced tirade as we dressed her bottom half and escorted her out to our patrol vehicles.</p> <p>I checked the inside of the apartment with Deputy Brown for a second person, but found none. It was unclear if a second person had fled the scene prior to our arrival, or if there had never been another person inside.</p> <p>Deputy Brown told me I had some slight redness on the side of my head, but it quickly faded. I did not experience any legitimate pain from the strike</p> | | | | |

and did not require any medical attention.

I cleared the scene a short while later; no further action taken.
